The Chelmsford School Committee has voted to allow up to fifteen (15) students living outside of Chelmsford to enroll in the Chelmsford Public Schools for the 2020-2021 school year as follows: two (2) students at McCarthy/Parker Middle School in Grade 5, twelve (12) students at Chelmsford High School in Grade 9, and one (1) student at Chelmsford High School in Grade 10. Students who enroll through school choice will be able to continue through graduation, barring disciplinary issues. Per the states' school choice regulations, these seats will be available to any Massachusetts student from outside of Chelmsford who applies. Transportation is not provided for school choice students.

If you wish to apply for admission to the Chelmsford Public Schools through school choice, please review the guidelines posted below, download and complete the application form, and submit a signed copy, along with the student's most recent report card, to the Chelmsford School Department, 230 North Road, Chelmsford, MA 01824, Attention Dr. Jay Lang, Superintendent of Schools. An application is required for each student applying and must be received by the deadline of [Friday, May 15, 2020 at 3:00 p.m.](#) in order to be considered in the lottery.

If all seats are filled by that date, applications received from that time will be placed at the end of the wait list in the order they are received.
