Tips & Tricks

to get students going on Paper

→ Share Paper, or learn together

Showing Paper in class and answering any questions students is a great way to share this resource with them. Alternatively, watch this [pre-recorded Paper webinar](#) together and discuss as a class.

→ Add Paper to assignments

Add Paper as a step in written assignments by directing students to submit their first draft to Essay Review. This step makes grading papers much faster!

→ Include Paper in your rubric

Offer extra credit for students who used the Live Help tutoring feature to ask a question with a Paper tutor, or Essay Review to review their written work prior to submission.

→ Try a Paper introduction activity

Try one of Paper's pre-made activities found on your teacher dashboard. These include teacher instructions, student instructions, and worksheets that you can easily plug-and-play as a homework assignment.

→ Remind students to use Paper to study

Before a test or exam, students can ask a tutor any questions they may have while studying -- try adding Paper to your email signature as a reminder that will help them get the help they need, any time of day.
