Our exchange experience begins by hosting a Spanish student here in Chelmsford for approx. 10 days.

Day 1: Spanish students and chaperones arrive at Logan Airport. They take a bus to CHS. Chelmsford families meet them at CHS and bring them home!

Day 2: Spanish students attend school and extracurriculars with CHS student. Welcome dinner in the evening for students, teachers, and host families.

Day 3: Spanish students attend school and extracurriculars with CHS student. Soccer game during PRIDE?!



Days 4-5: Your Spanish student is with you for the weekend! They will participate in your regular family activities. You can also take this opportunity to show them around:

- Go to the beach
- Local sporting event
- Day trip excursions: Ogunquit, ME, Portsmouth, NH, etc
- Go to the mall in Nashua
- Visit to Kimballs in Westford
- day trip to Boston



Days 6-10: Spanish students attend school with CHS student.

Last evening in Chelmsford: Goodbye dinner for students, families, and chaperones hosted by the school.

On the final weekend, they will depart for New York City and spend the weekend there before flying home to Spain.

- Transportation to and from school and events, as needed
- A single bed in a shared or private bedroom with access to a bathroom

DAYS 8 -9-FEB. 22ND -23RD EXCHANGE PROGRAM (FRIDAY – MONDAY)

- Days 8-9 in Málaga with host family
- Day 10: Overnight trip to Seville, Spain





- Sevilla is also known as the birthplace of Flamenco and the city where the most amazing Easter processions take place.
- Roll up your sleeves for a hands-on cooking workshop!
- Visit the Santa Cruz Quarter and explore the narrow streets and alleys of the old Judería (Jewish quarter). Tour the lavish Real Alcázar, the royal palace of both Moorish and Christian rulers for 11 centuries. Discover Plaza de España, a semi-circular brick building with a mixture of Baroque, Renaissance and Moorish styles, located inside Plaza Maria Luisa.
- Enjoy a meal with your group in a local restaurant.
- Night accommodation at your hotel in Seville.



- Walk up the "calle de las teterías" to the "Mirador de San Nicolás", and enjoy the amazing view of the Alhambra and Sierra Nevada Mountains.
