## English Instructor Recommendation Requirement

A student must have the following Reading/Writing skills to be eligible for ENG 101:

- **Independently read & interpret complex academic texts with multiple viewpoints**
  - Apply reading strategies and textual annotation to read actively, critically, and effectively
- **Critically evaluate ideas and information in texts**
  - Identify and interpret abstract concepts in readings
  - Examine perspectives represented in multiple texts
  - Develop legitimate inferences from evidence in the text
- **Write college level essays integrating ideas and information from texts to compose an expository, position paper**
  - Organize ideas clearly and effectively in writing
  - Formulate a thesis to focus writing
  - Support each point with substantial evidence
  - Develop writing to address a specific audience
  - Identify and correct major mechanical and grammatical errors
  - Synthesize ideas and information to develop point of view
