- All Athletes must have an up-to-date Physical on file in order to compete. Physicals are good for 13 Months from the date of Physical. Players are not allowed to participate with an expired Physical.
- All Injured Players, Players In Concussion Protocol, Players in Covid Return to Play
 must be cleared through Ms. Chagnon in the Athletic Office before being allowed to
 return to sports. Please inform Ms. Chagnon immediately of any information regarding
 these situations so she can begin to work on a Return to Play Policy and Timelines for all.
- A player is not cleared to play until Kate has cleared them.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY:

• In order to participate in Chelmsford High School Athletics, students must pass a minimum of 4 core classes. Failure to do so will result in removal from Athletic Contests until the next grading period closes (if the standards are now met to return).

CHEMICAL HEALTH VIOLATIONS:

- Chelmsford High School Athletics must follow the Chemical Health Violation Policy as set forth by the MIAA (The governing body of Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletics).
- Students who violate the Chemical Health Policy will follow the penalties listed in the MIAA Handbook.

- PARENTS SHOULD NOT TRY AND TALK TO A COACH/PLAYER/OFFICIAL DURING OR IMMEDIATELY AFTER A GAME OR PRACTICE.

FACILITY ACCESS

- All practices are considered closed to the public unless informed otherwise by a coach.
- Spectators will not be allowed into the facilities until 30 Minutes Prior to the start of the JV/Varsity Contest. The gyms need to be set up/cleaned. Staff will let people know when the facilities are open to spectators.
- Use of the facility without permission is not allowed.

FLETCHER FITNESS CENTER

- The Fletcher Fitness Center is located in the Gym Area and is open to all CHS Students on Monday-Thursday from 3:00PM to 4:00PM...
- Students are not allowed in the fitness center without supervision.
- Teams will use the Fitness Center as part of their practice plans.
- o Students should wipe down equipment when finished.
- Students should clean the room after they are finished.
- There is no eating in the fitness center.
- All music played in the Fitness Center must be clean.
- Failure to follow rules will result in not being allowed to use the Fitness Center.
- Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times.
- Proper footwear is required.

LOCKER ROOMS:

- Teams will be assigned locker rooms to change and leave their belongings.
- Locker Rooms will be unlocked and locked by the coaches.
- Players should not enter the locker rooms until the coach has given them permission and unlocked it for them.
- Cell Phone Use is NOT ALLOWED in the locker rooms.
- Students should lock their belongings if leaving them in a locker. Students should bring their own locks. These locks must be taken off at the end of the season or will be cut off.
- Students will not be allowed to use the locker room during the school day or on non-practice/game days.
- Failure to behave in an appropriate manner or any destruction or vandalism of the locker room can result in the teams/players losing access to the locker room.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS/COMMITMENT:

- All players are expected to attend every practice, game and team meeting.
- Players who are sick, and who have school, family, or religious obligations must inform their coach immediately if they will be missing practice.
- Not attending practice can affect playing time.
- All coaches and teachers will be able to work around academic extra help. Please let coaches know ahead of time.
- Athletes should NOT take vacations or miss time during the Athletic Season. Doing so can result in reduced playing time or removal from the team. (exception: college visits, family emergencies).
- Athletes can not miss a High School Sport Practice or Game to participate in a Club or AAU Practice or Game. Doing so is a violation of the MIAA Bona Fide Team Rule and will result in a suspension.

PICTURE DAY:

• DATE TBD 2PM in Stadium (Gym will be used as a backup location if we have weather) Teams should all wear their home uniforms for the pictures. Everyone will be notified in advance.

REGISTRATION/PAYMENT:

- All Student-Athletes must register via Google Form at: https://forms.gle/aydLtx9APnDmQXmK7
- Registration will begin on Thursday 6/1 and will close on Tuesday August 1.
- Payment information will not be entered at time of registration. .
- Students who have not registered may NOT compete in Fall Athletics.
- All Registered Athletes will be sent a payment link on April 3rd...
- A link to make payments will be sent to registered athletes on Thursday 8/31/23.
- All registration fees must be paid online via myschoolbucks by Friday 9/8/23.
- Students who have outstanding payments will not be able to participate until their payment has been completed.

- Exception: College Visit, Family Emergency, Doctor's Appointment (Non-Illness), Bereavement. These types of absences must be conveyed to the school immediately or ahead of time.
- All students should arrive to school on time.
- Students should not be dismissed from school on the days of competition. If a student is dismissed for a reason not listed in the exceptions to absence listed above, they will not be able to participate.
- Students who are Suspended (In School or Out of School) CAN NOT PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETICS on the days of suspension. If a student is suspended from school on a Friday, they can not participate in games or practices over the weekend period.
- Student-Athletes who receive Detentions must serve their detentions immediately. Failure to serve detentions will result in not being able to participate.

SPECTATORS:

- Noise-Makers are not allowed per MIAA Rules and will be confiscated and the user will be removed (Airhorns, whistles, etc.)
- Distracting Devices are not allowed per MIAA Rules (Laser Pointers, Flags, Etc.)
- Negative Fan Behavior will result in removal from the Event. Students who are removed from events will face a school consequence and will not be able to attend future school events. Adult Spectators who are removed from events will lose the right to attend contests for the 2023-2024 school year.
- The following behaviors will result in removal from Athletic Contests for Spectators:
 - Swearing
 - Targeting other players inappropriately
 - Disrespectful behavior towards Players, Coaches, Officials, Staff Workers or other spectators.
 - Entering the playing area. (All spectators must remain in designated fan sections and never enter the playing area.)
 - Taunting and/or Fighting (Can result in permanent removal from all sporting events, a school consequence and police involvement)
 - Throwing objects in the stands or from the stands onto the playing area will result in removal from the contest (Can result in permanent removal from all sporting events).
 - Student-Athletes who are removed from Athletic Contests that they are attending as spectators will be suspended from participating in their next Athletic Contest.
 - Students or Adults under the influence or possessing alcohol, drugs (including vape devices of any kind) will be removed from the event and subject to school/police consequences.
 - Racism of any form will not be tolerated by Chelmsford High School Athletics.
 Any forms of racism will result in removal, school punishment and police involvement. Chelmsford High School Athletics has zero tolerance for any forms of racism or racist behavior.

- Everyone must purchase tickets at this site or via the GoFan App and then present the tickets at the entrance with a game worker.



- VARSITY EVENTS in STADIUM. (JV Events in Stadium will need tix if before Varsity Events)
- o Girls Varsity Volleyball in CHS Conrad Gymnasium.
- Information will be sent to all with ticketing info at visiting schools. *Unless informed ahead of time, please assume that all schools will charge admission at the gate. We will make everyone aware of schools that are doing Digital Ticketing Only.*
- Conference Championships, Track Meets, and Conference and MIAA Meets and Invitationals will charge an admission fee. We will make everyone aware of these prices ahead of time.

TRANSPORTATION:

- Transportation to away contests in the Fall is provided for all athletic teams.
 - For the last year, we have dealt with a transportation shortage which has caused some schedules to change.
 - If a bus is canceled, we will first try to provide transportation via our CHS Mini-Buses (if they are available).
 - o If we can not get teams/players to events via a regular bus or a minibus we will then ask parents if they can either drive players. (This is only done as a last resort. We will do everything possible to provide transportation for our athletes.)

UNIFORMS

- Student Athletes are responsible for the proper care of their uniforms,
- Most uniforms are custom-made and can not be duplicated easily. Lost uniforms will result in the Student-Athlete being billed by Chelmsford High School.
- All Items given by the school should be returned to the Coach at the end of the season.
- Players who have not returned their items will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities and/or sports until their items have been returned.
