Associate Pathway

The following pages outline the path students will need to take in order to earn enough credits to complete an Associate Degree by the end of their senior year.

COURSES IN BLUE MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CHS GRADUATION.

DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES IN RED MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ASSOCIATE DEGREE AND CHS GRADUATION.

SCORE OF 3 OR HIGHER IS REQUIRED ON AP PSYCHOLOGY EXAM FOR COLLEGE CREDIT.

The dual enrollment courses will also meet the requirements for your CHS diploma. Students interested in this path will need to meet with the Career and College Facilitator and their guidance counselor regularly to ensure that they are on target to meet the requirements.

Expected Costs

Students/families are responsible for the cost of all dual enrollment courses after a student registers with Middlesex Community College. Tuition costs \$126 per credit. Most classes offered at CHS are 3 credits or \$378 total. Some of the science courses are 4 credit classes and will cost \$504 total. The cost of tuition is subject to change annually.
